




For those seeking rest and rejuvenation, Antwerp has excellent wellness centres where you can enjoy saunas, massages and thermal baths.

From historic architecture to beautiful museums:
Antwerp has a lot to offer. The city is also known as
a veritable paradise for fashion enthusiasts. The Fashion
District is the city's creative fashion hub. This is where you
will find the Fashion Museum Antwerp (MoMu); with its
changing exhibitions, this is a must-visit for fashionistas.
Schuttershofstraat (which runs into Hopland), Kammenstraat
and Korte Gasthuisstraat are home to the city's best
boutiques. But you will also find plenty of nice shops
on the small streets around there.

Meir, Antwerp's famous shopping street, is home to the biggest retail chains. The Stadsfeestzaal shopping mall is also located there. This building is over 100 years old and worth a visit in itself. The glass dome with gold leaf is particularly impressive. So, make sure you look up too.

If you plan to do some serious Sunday shopping during this city break, keep in mind that most shops in Antwerp are closed on Sundays except for the first Sunday of the month. The shops on Kloosterstraat, however, are open every Sunday.

SCHUTTERSHOFSTRAAT, LATIN QUARTER

In the heart of the popular Latin Quarter, you will find Schuttershofstraat. This is the place to be for anyone who loves high fashion and exclusive watches! Schuttershofstraat and the surrounding streets (Hopland, Leopoldstraat, Komedieplaats) are home to boutiques and flagship stores of world-famous brands such as Hermès, Louis Vuitton, Chanel, Burberry, Delvaux, IRO, Pinko and many others.

MIGLOT Parfums, the Belgian perfume house of perfumer Kristof Lefebre, is on Leopoldstraat. You will find exclusive, gender-neutral fragrances in small editions, in a minimalist design with a warm human touch.

SINT-JORISPOORT, CENTRE

Just a few minutes' walk from the city centre is a tucked-away neighbourhood where every establishment exudes style: Sint-Jorispoort. You will find all kinds of quaint and unique shops, such as In 't Zonneke, known for its wide range of authentic and traditionally made door and furniture fittings. Quest for Diamonds is an exclusive jewellery and perfume store, while at Bloemen van Cornelis you will find the season's finest flowers, lush plants and an impressive collection of vases and other pottery. Finally, there is De Messenwinkel, a specialist in knives and shaving tools, and also the oldest shop in Antwerp.

DE WILDE ZEE, CENTRE

The Wilde Zee neighbourhood is made up of five pedestrian streets in the heart of Antwerp. Here, you can stroll at your leisure along De Korte Gasthuisstraat, Wiegstraat, Lombardenvest, Groendalstraat and Schrijnwerkersstraat. You will find trendy boutiques and fashionable brands, and, for an energy boost while shopping, you can call at **Bakkerij Goossens**. This family-run business is located in an authentic little store on Korte Gasthuisstraat that you will recognise from a distance by the queue of people waiting patiently for their turn to shop. They are known for their delicious cookies and the traditional Antwerp Roggeverdommeke, a rye bread filled with raisins

On Schrijnwerkersstraat, we find **Pierre Marcolini**, an exquisite Belgian master chocolatier.

Next to the shop area, you will also see a large, open production space. He roasts and grinds the cocoa beans himself until he obtains his signature chocolate with its specific flavour. For his Antwerp workshop, he selects cocoa beans from places including Madagascar, Sao Tomé, Indonesia, Tamil Nadu (India) and southern China

KAMMENSTRAAT, CENTRE

Do you like striking fashion brands that you can't find everywhere? Then Kammenstraat is the place to be. There's **O My Bag**, for example, a sustainable bag brand, available at Studio Play and Wear Antwerp. There are also some lovely vintage shops to wander through here.



MEIR, CENTRE

Meir is a pedestrian, commercial hotspot in the city of Antwerp, connecting Central Station with the historic centre. Here you can shop at the biggest retail chains. Meir has a rich history and contains historic buildings such as the **Royal Palace on the Meir** and the **Stadsfeestzaal**. The latter is a large shopping centre housed in an old festival hall.



KLOOSTERSTRAAT, SINT-ANDRIES

Another thing you can do in Antwerp is source beautiful furniture, antiques and jewellery! The best place for this is Kloosterstraat. Here you can hunt around for treasures in all kinds of antique shops and concept stores. The focus here is not on clothing. Take a look at antique furniture shop **Blue Fonz**, for example, or call in at **Anna+Nina** for trendy jewellery! A fun fact: the shops are open daily on Kloosterstraat.

Dynamic parking guidance will direct you with ease to a car park with available spaces. Payment can be made via a parking app, SMS or bank card.
